- Anyone that wants to know the latest in research and clinical practice around women and girls in sport, and how to better support their athletes through valuable networking.

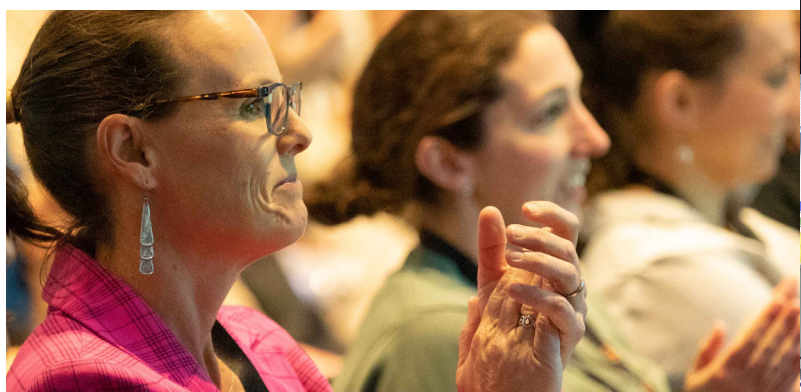


## Themes

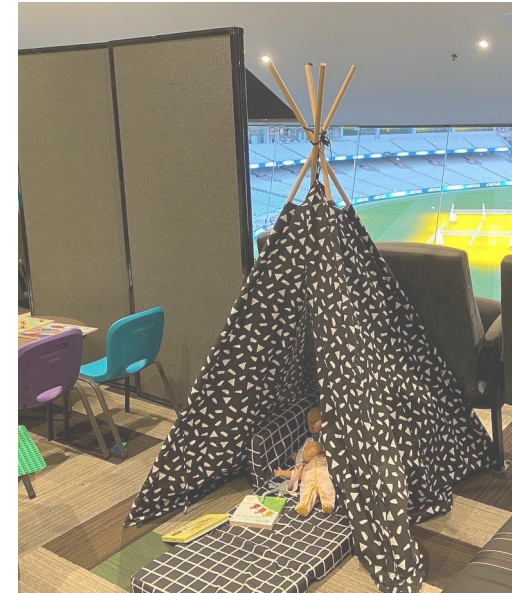
